



Introduction

Application for Registration of a Light Motor Vehicle or Trailer (AA) Form have been re-printed & are being released to Service Tasmania outlets. The purpose for this SIB is to inform VE's of the changes to the AA's.

Background

This reverts the AA's back to the version released in October 2021, with a few minor additions. These changes are necessary to enable the correct vehicle details to be recorded. Taking into consideration the Commonwealth's *Road Vehicle Standards Act (SIB 03-2021)* and changes in relation to MAIB premiums for electric powered motorcycles.

What are the changes

Vehicle Identification Section of AA

1. Date of Australian Compliance/**RAV ENTRY**/Manufacture.
 - a. The new RAV ENTRY relates to a vehicle built under an approval granted under the new *Road Vehicle Standards Act*
 - b. VEs are to record the RAV Date of Entry in the month and year field. See *SIB 03 - 2021*.
2. **Register of Approved Vehicle Yes/No.**
 - a. This relates to vehicles recorded on the Register of Approved Vehicles (RAV) and relates to *SIB 03-2021* as released in July this year. If the vehicle is a pre RAV vehicle or not recorded on the RAV then tick NO, if it is recorded on the RAV then tick YES.
3. **Special Interest (SI) Registration A B C.**
 - a. This relates to the Class of SI registration as outlined in the LVAIS Procedure Manual with
 - i. **Class A** - greater than 30 years old and meeting the RMV eligibility criteria (*LVAISIM Section 18*),
 - ii. **Class B** - race rally and
 - iii. **Class C** - exclusively for charitable events e.g. Tasbash vehicles.

Note: Prior to AIS Inspection of vehicles presented for **SI Inspection Classes B & C**, written approval in principle issued by Registrar of Motor Vehicles is required. The customer must advise the VE what class of SI registration is being requested.
4. Modification Plate **Serial** Number.
 - a. This relates to the serial number of each modification plate.

- b. On Tasmanian issued Mod Plates the serial no. is visible in the top left-hand corner in the silver band.
- c. If the vehicle has a number of mod plates affixed, VEs are to record the serial number of the latest mod plate on the AA but on your VE Checklist please record the other plate/s by serial no/s and mod codes in the comments section or consider taking a photo of each one for your records.

Vehicle Specification Section of AA

- 5. **Body Type** box we have split it into two sub headings – **Vehicle** and **Trailer**.
 - a. Added **Camper** to the Caravan heading. **Caravan/Camper**.
 - b. **Caravan** - An enclosed trailer, which is intended for use as a mobile home or living quarters when parked. It will usually provide fixed sleeping accommodation and/or facilities for the preparation of food. A trailer permanently equipped with a folding and stowable roof (such as a camper trailer) is a caravan. Enclosed trailers constructed for the accommodation of people when parked such as workers' amenity trailers, mobile kitchens or mobile offices are also regarded as caravans.
 - c. **NOTE – definition of a Plant Trailer** – refers to a piece of plant that is trailered (e.g. a compressor trailer, concrete mixer, mobile electric generator, or a mobile latrine) and the trailer does NOT have a load carrying capacity. It does not relate to a trailer that is designed to carry a separate piece of plant that is loaded and unloaded.
- 6. **Primary Motive Power** reinstated the **KW box** where the output of motorcycles powered by Electric Motor/s is recorded in KW. If a motorcycle has multiple electric motors (e.g. separate wheel motors) the combined power output of all motors is to be recorded as the total KW output. If the motorcycle is not electric powered or is a hybrid vehicle the KW box can be left blank.
- 7. Number of **electric motors** box added requiring VE to record the Number of electric motors fitted to the vehicle being inspected.

- 8. VE Checklist Book No added – requiring VE's to identify the Serial Number of the VE's Checklist book the AA is completed in. This portion has been added as an AIS Audit tool to assist AIS Compliance.

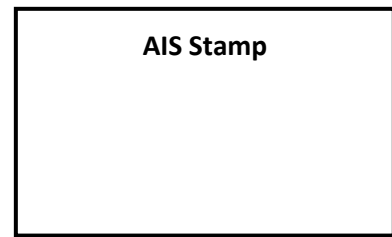
