Accredited Taxi Operators - Taxi Labels issued by the Transport Commission

This Fact Sheet summarises important information about labels and signs issued by the Transport Commission for display in taxis under r10 of the *Taxi and Hire Vehicle Industries Regulations* 2023.

This is not an exhaustive list of all labels and signs you may be required to display in your taxi.

l | Taxi Fare Labels

The Commission issues taxi fare labels, which are notices to passengers of the fares and charges approved for your taxi. You must not charge more than the maximum fare.

Two Taxi Fare Labels must be affixed in each taxi. The Taxi Fare Labels must be affixed in a prominent place in both the front and rear of the taxi so that passengers can see them.

2 | Security Camera Test Labels

The Commission has approved labels as evidence of testing of your security camera system. This is required if your taxi operates in a security camera taxi area. These labels are issued when your security camera system is tested, which must happen at least every 12 months.

The Security Camera Test Label must be affixed to the upper left-hand side of the inside of the windscreen.

3 Security Camera Operating Signs

The Security Camera Operating Sign is a rectangular sticker you put on each door to warn passengers that you have a camera in your taxi.

The Security Camera Operating Sign must be clearly legible and fitted above and adjacent to each external door handle, including the external rear door handle if the vehicle has rear access for wheelchairs or if the vehicle is a van. It must not be fitted to a movable glass section that is capable of obstructing clear view of the sign. It must be at least 50mm high and at least 150mm wide.

Please note: Labels 2 and 3 are only required if your taxi operates in a Security Camera Taxi Area. The Security Camera Taxi Areas are: Burnie, Devonport, Hobart, Huonville, Launceston, Perth and Ulverstone.
